Therefore pursuant to **Section 11-46-55 (d), Code of Alabama 1975, as amended**, *If no candidate receives a majority of all the votes cast in such election for any one office or offices for the election to which there were more than two candidates, then the municipal governing body shall order a second or runoff election to be held on the sixth Tuesday next thereafter following the regular election,* .


